On every Friday the angels take their stand at every gate of the Mosque to write the names of the people according to the time of their arrival for Friday Prayer and when the Imam sits (on the pulpit for Khutba) they fold up their scrolls and get ready to listen to the Sermon. (Abu Hurairah Bukhari)
- 3. O Ayesha! This is Jibrail and he sends his greetings to you. Ayesha said, "Greetings to him and Allah's mercy and blessing be on him." and addressing to the Prophet she said "you see what I don't see."

ANGELS IN HADITH - B

- 4. Angels keep on descending from and ascending to the Heaven in turn, some at night and some by daytime and all of them assemble together at the time of FAJR and ASR prayers. Then those who have stayed with you over night, ascent unto Allah, Who asks them –and He knows the answer better- "How have you left my servant?" They reply, "We have left them praying as we found them praying." (Abu Hurairah Bukhari)
- Angels (of mercy) do not enter a house wherein there is a dog or a picture of a living creature (a human being or an animal).
 (Abu Talha Bukhari)
- 6. Hazrat Abdullah Ibn Mas'ud said that the Prophet (Peace be upon him) had seen ЛВRAIL having 600 wings.

 (Zir Bin Hubaish Bukhari)
